
2 Insert all Locking Clips into all connectors 9255.





Assemble the base, attaching parts 9040 & 1068 to the connectors.




Assemble the crossbar and the upright section, attaching 9040 & 1051 to connectors.





Fit the crossbar (step 4) to the base (step 3), affixing the 2 x 1051 to the 2 x 9255.





Place the net over the frame. The Net World Sports label indicates the top of the net. This needs to be at the top of the crossbar.

Starting with the top corners, fit the net by wrapping it around the posts and clipping to the inside using the net clips provided. Attach clips equally along the length of the net.
